

## A SHORT COURSE IN GRAPHOLOGY

### Introduction

Graphology is a stimulating and fascinating subject and this short 'teach-yourself' course, designed to help you find out more about *how* and *why* it really works, is now available 'free' to members of the B.I.G.!

This short but fully illustrated course introduces some basic principles of the B.I.G. method. It contains fifty samples of handwriting, thirty exercises, a worksheet, and an example analysis. Answers to the exercises are included in a companion workbook.

This user-friendly course shows you (in *easy-to-understand* language) what to look for in handwriting, what it might mean, and how to do an analysis and interpretation yourself. Once completed, it will enable you to link handwriting with personality traits and increase your insight into people's characters, using a simple worksheet to approach the complex task of analysis.

Please note that this course is merely a taster, and will *not* enable you to qualify as a professional graphologist through the B.I.G.. (More detailed worksheets are required for B.I.G. diploma exams - which are in three parts - and the Part 1 syllabus is not fully covered in this short course).
